

## Payment Policy

## **Choir Members**

Choir members pay an annual subscription which is spread over 12 months at £22.50/month, paid by standing order (£270/year).

This is equivalent to six half terms a year @ £45/term (£270/year). It may be helpful to think that being a member of FCGC is like attending an adult education class. You would have to pay for a full term regardless of the number of times you attend the class.

If you are going to miss a complete half term, you may withhold £45, but if you are going to attend any part of a half term there is no fee deduction. (Please see table below) Term dates will be notified on our website.

If you are going to be away for a long period, please let Georgie or Ruth know. Please plan ahead as fees cannot be refunded.

If you decide that you never want to come to choir again you are free to cancel your standing order.

It really helps with our accounts if you set up the standing order for the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month.

## **Drop-Ins**

Everyone is invited to a free taster session. After that you can join the choir, or we welcome anyone who wants to come along on an occasional Wednesday. The fee for this drop-in is £15 payable on the day. These visitors will be able to fully participate in the workshops, but will not become choir members, will not have access to songs on website and will not be able to perform in concerts.

## To make it easier to understand:

We meet for 36 weeks of the year (usually three 12 week terms).

The cost of being a member is based on each session costing £7.50

£7.50 x 36 = £270 - this is the annual fee

£270  $\div$  12 = £22.50 - this is the monthly fee

If you are going to be away for ALL of a half term, please cancel your payments according to this table:
